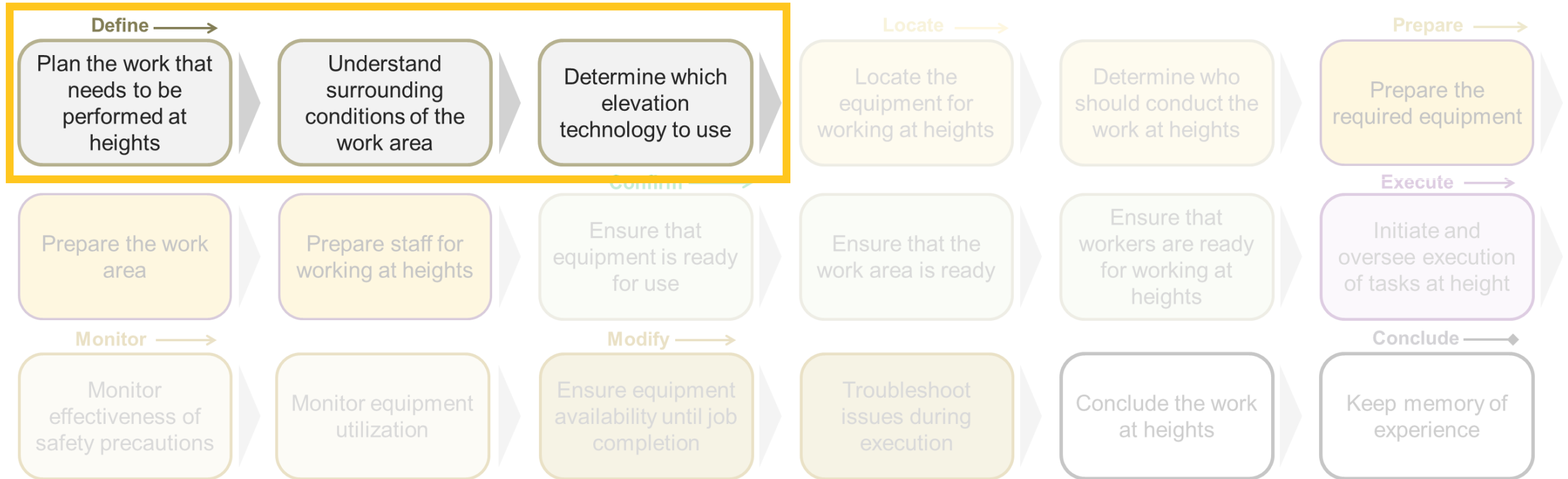

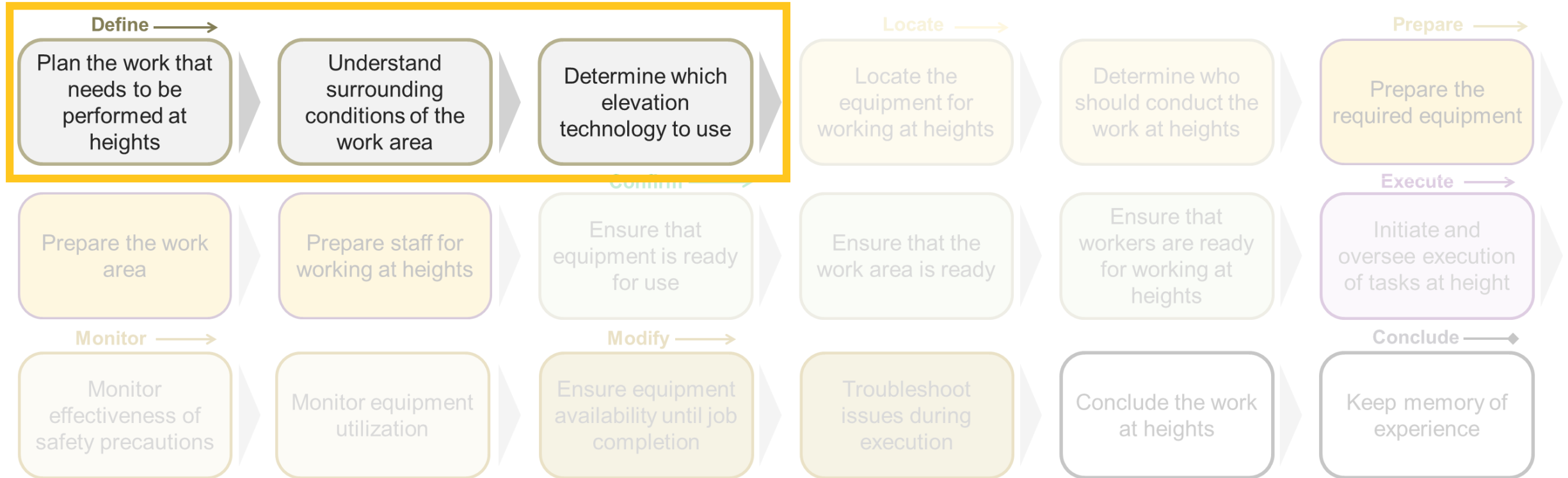


THE EARLY STEPS OF THE JOB MAP REVEALED POTENTIAL



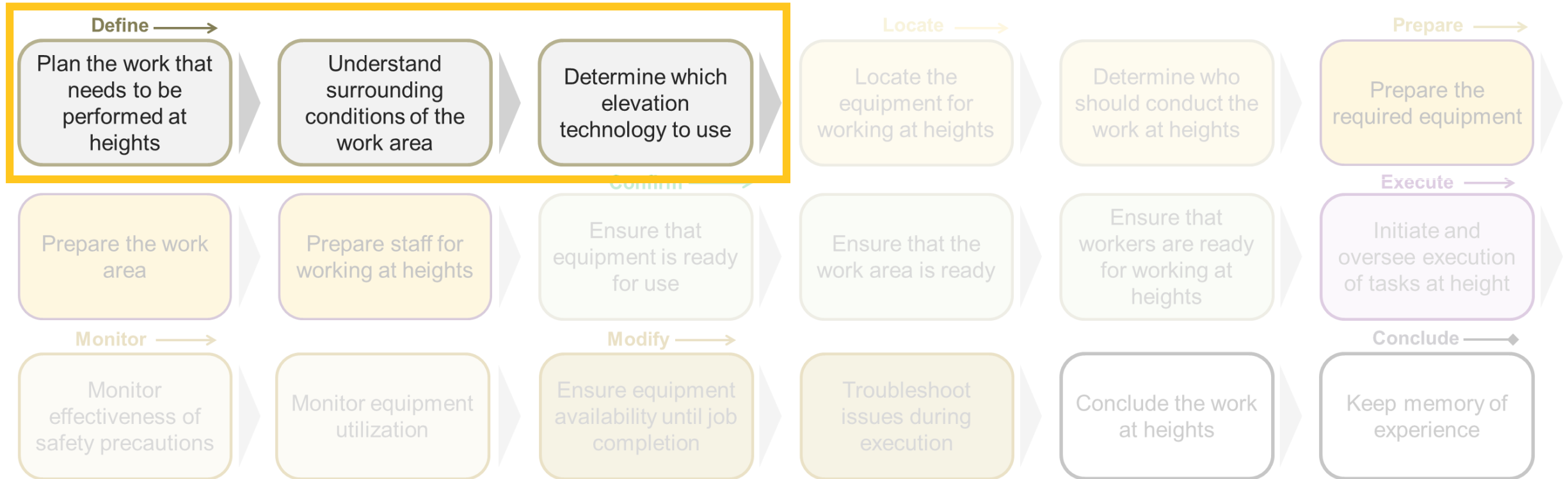
“Minimize the likelihood of making incorrect assumptions about the space that is available for equipment operation, e.g., overestimate space for positioning equipment, overlook narrow passages on transport routes, etc.”

“Minimize the time it takes to decide which type of equipment to use, e.g., type of aerial work platform, type of ladder, type of scaffolding, etc.”

“Minimize the time it takes to determine what other work will be going on that could interfere with the job, e.g., dependencies with preceding work, other trades on-site, safety zones for neighboring areas, etc.”
